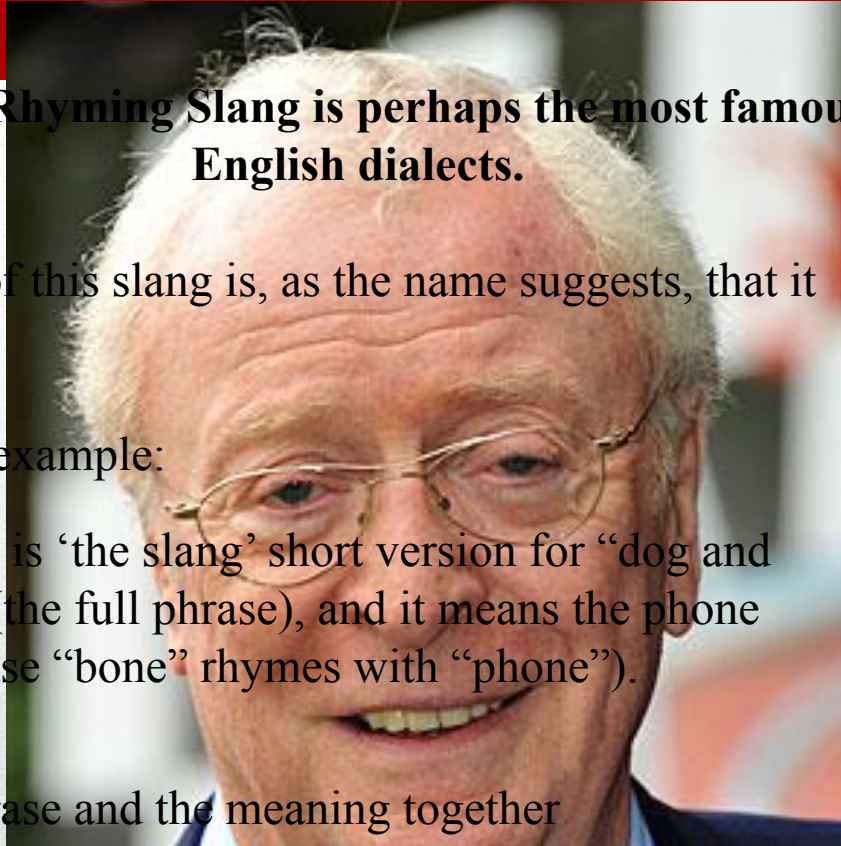


**Cockney Rhyming Slang is perhaps the most famous of English dialects.**
