

SUPERLATIVE ADJECTIVES

We use the superlative to compare more than two people, places or things.

- Short adjective + EST.
old □ *the oldest*
young □ *the youngest*
- CVC + EST (the final consonant is doubled)
big □ *the biggest*
hot □ *the hottest*
- Short adjective ended in -Y □ -IEST
easy □ *the easiest*
heavy □ *the heaviest*

- Long adjective: THE MOST + long adjective
exciting □ *the most exciting*
beautiful □ *the most beautiful*
- Irregular adjectives
good □ *the best*
bad □ *the worst*
Far □ *the fartherst*
Little □ *the least*
Much? Many □ *the most*
- We use THE before the superlative form of the adjective.
John is the tallest.
A Ferrari is the most expensive car .
