Roy Jones Jr. was born January 16, 1969 in the small town of Pensacola, Florida, son, from childhood, his father, in the past a good professional boxer Roy tried to April a love of boxing, he wanted to raise the champion, who himself was not destined to become. But with only 11 years old Roy began boxing. Weighing less than 120kg, Jones was 14 year old young boxer weighing 25 kg. It was only the beginning. Already in 1984 he won the Junior Olympic in the U.S., and two years later won a prestigious national tournament the U.S. "Golden Gloves". Of course, in an amateur career, as well as any other boxer, there were defeats. It is remarkable that he has lost our boxer Cyril Rutherford at the Soviet Union in 1986 on points. And now for the Olympic Games (1988 in Seoul), the world was quite new, and it appeared before it as that, but long forgotten boxing talent of this phenomenon, which is sharply blinded and made a breathless delight.

thoroughly pleased representative U.S. Olympic team being junior welterweight champion (up to 75 kg) Roy Jones. Roy went to the group of any amateur boxer - a gold medal Olympic Games. The ease with which he beat his older and hardened boxing fights opponents suggest that the advent of professional boxing with Roy gets a new, previously unknown quantity, which for many years to establish itself as the defining. But only just a prediction soon came true, after all, a brilliant gold medal Roy never won. By decision of the judges, which was recognized as the worst in the history of the Olympic Games, the South Korean opponent Kim Park Jr. had received the "gold", winning 5-0. It was a surprise for both present of the fight fans for his father's Roy Jones Jr., and for himself a style champion. In connection with the scandal Tushnet International Olympic Committee (IOC) is an attempt to rectify the situation, handed the award to Roy Vaj Barber, which is awarded only to the best boxer, though it certainly could not have been replaced by Olympic gold medal. And after the disappointment of the Olympic, many arguments and reflections Roy still goes to the gym, starting to set in the middleweight (up to 72.5 kg) and shortly Jones Capture numerous recognitions that in the face of boxing got to master with a unique style, he began to continue forming out the victory over of the most powerful cruiser weight - a single blow to the body was knocked out former champion, WBA Vinyl Hill, was a consensus decision the defending champion Luis Del Valle in version WBA. TBC defeated former champion (Ole Green, Reggie Johnson, Eric Harding, Derek Hansen, Julia Szustak... WBC presents Roy Award "for Achievement in the Life," a place in the ring ahead for Frank, which is rated the best boxer of the world regardless of weight categories (by the way this place is it or held until late in a career and a total of about 11 years). The word "victory" and "Roy Jones" became synonymous. American Association of journalists writing about boxing, called Jones "Boxer decade" in the 90s. He headed the rating board for good breaking of the best fighters regardless of weight category according to the magazine "The Ring" from 1996 to 2000.

I salute him because he is one of the greatest professional boxers. His fighting style is amazing, his speed is amazing, his strikes the ring as the show or demonstrations. I like his style.
